**REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION TO PROGRAM:			
I. Proof of Rubella (3-day) Measles: (A or B)			
A. Laboratory evidence (positive serological titer- submit actual laboratory results) OR			
B. Documented evidence of 2 Rubella vaccinations on or after 12 months of age. (at least 4 weeks apart) (signatures required for each vaccination)			
II. Proof of Rubeola (Hard) Measles: (A or B)			
A. Laboratory evidence (positive serological titer- submit actual laboratory results) OR			
B. Documentation of receipt of 2 Measles vaccinations on or after 12 months of age. (at least 4 weeks apart) (signatures required for each vaccination)			
III. Mumps Immunity: (A or B)			
A. Laboratory evidence (positive serological titer- submit actual laboratory results) OR			
B. Documented evidence of 2 Mumps vaccinations on or after 12 months of age. (at least 4 weeks apart) (signatures required for each vaccination)			
IV. Varicella-zoster (Chickenpox) Immunity: (A or B)			
A. Laboratory evidence (positive serological titer- submit actual laboratory results) OR			
B. Documentation of receipt of 2 Varicella vaccinations. (4-6 weeks apart) (signatures required for each vaccination)			
**REQUIRED AFTER PROVISIONAL ACCEPTANCE TO THE PROGRAM:			
I. Hepatitis B Vaccine: (A or B or C)			
A. Laboratory evidence (positive serological titer- submit actual laboratory results) OR			
B. Documented evidence of 3 Hepatitis B vaccinations. (signatures required for each vaccination) OR			
C. Declination form signed/copy attached.			
II. Proof of 2 PPD's/TST's (Intermediate Strength (Mantoux Method) TB Skin Test) within the last 365 days OR Chest X-Ray (if positive reactor only) and documentation of treatment.			
III. Tetanus (current within last 10 years)			

1. Any live vaccines such as (MMR/Varicella) have to be given on the same day. If not given on the same day, you must wait 6 weeks between vaccinations.
2. The Tuberculin Skin Test (TST/PPD) should be given a minimum of 1 week prior to receiving a live vaccination to avoid a false positive result. Otherwise, you must wait 6 weeks after receiving a live vaccine (MMR/Varicella) before TST/PPD testing.
3. If a student has never had chickenpox disease (Varicella) he/she should **not** have a titer drawn but should receive 2 Varicella vaccinations.
4. MMR vaccinations must be **STRICTLY** separated by 4 weeks or more (not one day earlier!)
5. All documentation of immunizations requires a **Healthcare Provider signature**, the date, and record of the results (for TST/PPD), on institutional letterhead which reflects the address and telephone number of the location where the immunization was given. Immunization cards will be accepted as long as the results are documented and the dates are readable/legible.
