

Nursing Admissions Process

FOR FALL 2010

Phase 1

Initial Steps:

- Attend **REQUIRED orientation** for year applying.
- Apply for admission to Aims through Admissions and Records.
- Meet the assessment requirement.
- Schedule the **REQUIRED** initial pre-nursing advising appointment.

Initial Pre-nursing Advising Appointment (Required):

- Review and collect all orientation documents.
- Review assessment scores and/or transcripts.
- Develop admission plan.
- Register for courses.

Phase 2

Actively work on completing ALL nursing prerequisite requirements for ability to "apply" for nursing program admission.

NOTE: Bio 216-Pathophysiology will be the only course permitted to be in progress Spring 2010 term for those who are applying for Fall 2010 admission to Nursing program. Documentation of enrollment will be required at the application appointment.

Phase 3

Apply for Fall 2010:

- Gather all required documentation demonstrating completion of all prerequisite requirements.
- Schedule **required** appointment with an advisor to submit documents in person from first working day in February to last working day in March for fall 2010.

Begin calling 11/09/09 to schedule application appointment for Feb. 2010

Phase 4

Final Screening Criteria:

- For Fall 2010 only - students who are on the waitlist, completed prerequisites and applied.
- G.P.A. on nursing general education course requirements. (minimum 2.5)

Selected Students given Provisional Acceptance

Required to submit record of:

- Tetanus less than 10 years old
- 2 negative TB Skin tests within 365 days
- Hepatitis B vaccines, titer, or waiver
- Current Healthcare Provider CPR
- Completed background check and urine drug screen (UA)

Phase 2

Completed Prerequisite Requirements for Fall 2010 Applicants

(Must be completed BEFORE application appointment)

1. College prep coursework with "C" or better.
2. Nursing general education prerequisite courses:
PSY 235, ENG 121, BIO 105/106/111, BIO 201, BIO 202,
& BIO 216
3. Minimum GPA of 2.5 in PSY 235, ENG 121, BIO 201,
BIO 202 & BIO 216
4. Official transcripts evaluated, transferred to Aims and
applied to student record.
5. Immunizations: Documentation of Varicella (2 vaccines)
and Mumps, Measles and Rubella (2 vaccines); or titers
for Varicella and Measles, Mumps, and Rubella.
6. Fingerprinting process complete. Copy of results from
American Databank must be confirmed, cleared and on
file with Nursing Department.
7. Documentation of possessing active C.N.A. license.
8. Passing scores on the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS).
*Must meet or exceed ADN Program Mean for Composite, Math, &
Reading for given application year. All results must be from same test.
All NET scores are invalid.*
Composite: 75.4% Math: 65.9% Reading: 88.1%
9. Eligible to register (no holds, current application on file.)
