

# Nursing Admissions Process

## FOR FALL 2009

Non waitlist

## Phase 1

### Initial Steps:

- Attend **REQUIRED orientation.**
- Apply for admission to the college through Admissions and Records.
- Meet the assessment requirement.
- Schedule the REQUIRED initial pre-nursing advising appointment.

### Initial Pre-nursing Advising Appointment (Required):

- Review and collect all orientation documents.
- Review assessment scores and/or transcripts.
- Develop admission plan.
- Register for courses.

## Phase 2

**Actively work on completing ALL nursing prerequisite requirements for ability to "apply" for nursing program admission.**

***NOTE:** ALL prerequisite requirements must be completed, nothing can be in progress at the time of application.*

## Phase 3

### Apply for Fall 2009:

- Gather all required documentation demonstrating completion of all prerequisite requirements.
- Schedule required appointment with an advisor to submit documents in person from first working day in February to last working day in March for fall 2009.

## Phase 4

### Final Screening Criteria:

- For Fall 2009 and 2010 - students who are on the waitlist, completed prerequisite and applied.
- G.P.A. on nursing general education course requirements. (minimum 2.5)

### Selected Students given Provisional Acceptance

Required to submit record of:

- Tetanus less than 10 years old
- Tb less than 30 days old
- Chickenpox immunization or titer
- Current Healthcare Provider CPR
- Current healthcare insurance
- Completed background check and urine analysis

# Phase 2

## Completed Prerequisite Requirements for Fall 2009 Applicants

*(Must be completed BEFORE application appointment)*

1. Developmental coursework with "C" or better.
2. Nursing general education prerequisite courses:  
PSY 235, ENG 121, BIO 105, BIO 201, BIO 202, & BIO 216
3. Minimum GPA of 2.5 in PSY 235, ENG 121, BIO 201,  
BIO 202 & BIO 216
4. Official transcripts evaluated, transferred to Aims and  
applied to student account.
5. Immunizations: Hepatitis B (3 shots) and Mumps, Measles  
and Rubella (2 shots); or titers for Hepatitis B and Mumps,  
Measles and Rubella.
6. Fingerprinting process complete. Provide copy of results  
from American Databank to academic advisor.
7. Documentation of possessing active C.N.A. license.
8. Passing scores on the NET (Nurse Entrance Exam).  
Reading: 55 and Math: 65
9. Eligible to register (no holds, current application on file.)
