Using CQ Researcher

What is CQ Researcher?

CQ Researcher offers in-depth, non-biased reports on a variety of political and social issues by topic or by date. It is a great source for selecting a research topic.

On Campus Access

- Go to the library home page at <http://www.aims.edu/kieferlibrary/index.html>
- Click on **Databases & Article Search**.
- Click on **Complete List of Databases**.
- Scroll down to **CQ Researcher**.
- Click on **CQ Researcher**.

Off Campus Access

- Go to the library home page at <http://www.aims.edu/kieferlibrary/index.html>
- Go to **Off Campus Access** on the left side of the screen.
- Type in your Web Services username and password.
- Click on **CQ Researcher**.

Finding Articles

- Type your search terms in the **Quick Search** box located on the left hand side of your screen.
- Click on **GO**.
- Click on an article title from the list.
- A table of contents will appear on the top of the screen. Click on a section you would like to read.
- The first page of the section will appear. Read through the sections by using the scroll bar on the right hand side of the page.
- The table of contents will remain on the top of the page. You may jump to any section at any time.
- You can copy from the article into a MS Word document, print the article, or email the text to yourself.
