

Admission and Enrollment Process

GENERAL

Aims Community College (Aims) is participating in the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program during this academic year. If you are eligible and approved for WUE tuition rates, you will pay reduced tuition rates equal to one and one-half times the normal out-of-district rates in place of the out-of-state rates.

ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Follow admission procedures/instructions detailed on Aims Web Site:
2. Submit a completed Western Undergraduate Exchange Program Verification for Residency Application form (available from Admissions) with your Application for Admission.
3. Submit an Affidavit of Lawful Presence and provide approved documentation for it with your WUE application. Affidavit can be found on the aims website at:

4. Admissions will notify you of your approval or disapproval for WUE tuition rates.
