



For CSU students taking an Aims Course

This signed form is to be submitted to the Business Office/Accounts Receivable at Aims Community College at the time of registration to avoid required down payment, late fees, or dropping of classes by the College.

Aims Community College and Colorado State University Cooperative Registration Agreement

Purpose: To provide students enrolled at either institution the opportunity to complete undergraduate courses at the other without additional tuition assessment.

Eligibility: Students must be enrolled at the home institution in resident institution-instruction courses (i.e. not Continuing Education) and be registered for 12 academic credits (9 credits for Summer) for the corresponding term for which they are registering at the host institution. i.e.

Course Restriction: Registration for a maximum of one undergraduate, resident instruction (i.e. not Continuing Education) course (5 credits) per term is authorized. Registration will be subject to the availability of the course and the student meeting the prerequisites.

Tuition: Tuition and student fees for the course taken under this agreement will not be charged to the eligible student. Applicable course fees will be paid by the student. If the student is determined to be ineligible for this cooperative registration agreement, applicable tuition and student fees will be assessed, and the student will be responsible for payment of these charges.

Verification: Aims students will obtain a certifying form from the Aims Admissions and Records Office which will identify them as eligible for the privilege. CSU students will sign an agreement form at the Aims Business Office/Accounts Receivable at the time of registration. Normal Aims procedures for admissions and registration will apply. At the end of the term final verification of the student's eligibility will be sent by the home institution registrar to the host institution registrar. Eligibility is determined by the students total number of enrolled hours at the home institution and students registration at the host institution. Completion of the course is not used in determining the students eligibility for this agreement.

By signing this agreement, I am verifying that I am eligible for the Cooperative Registration Agreement between Aims Community College and Colorado State University for _____(semester/year) at Aims. Further, if at any time while enrolled in courses at Aims Community College I become ineligible for the program as determined by either institution, I will indemnify Aims Community College for any costs incurred including tuition and lab fees.
