

Guidelines for Completing the Academic Reentry Plan for Academically Suspended Students

Students who have been academically suspended and wish to return to Aims Community College must do the following:

1. Meet with a Retention Advisor in the Student Success Center prior to starting classes. Please call 970-339-6251 to make your appointment.
2. Complete the Academic Reentry Plan and Analysis of Poor Course Performance prior to your appointment with the Retention Advisor. The other forms in the packet will be completed during your appointment with the Retention Advisor. 3. The completed re-admission packet includes:
 - a. Reentry Plan for Academically Suspended Students (signed by your Retention Advisor)
 - b. Analysis of Course Poor Performance
 - c. Worksheet for Course Grades Needed
 - d. Commitments for Academic Reentry
4. Students are allowed to reenroll after completing the Academic Reentry Plan.
5. Students will remain on Academic Probation as long as the cumulative GPA is under 2.00.
6. Students must achieve a 2.00 GPA during the reentry term, or be placed on Academic Suspension for the second time.
 - a. Students who are academically suspended a second time must sit out one calendar year.
 - b. Students are eligible to appeal the suspension.
