

Nurse Aide Student Checklist

Required documentation & items due at the beginning of the FIRST day of Nurse Aide class include:

- Nurse Aide Orientation form signed & dated by presenter.
- All supplies listed on the Nurse Aide Orientation form.
- Receipt or email confirmation of ordering the Background Check.
- Official documentation of the following (“shot” records or official printout from Doctor’s office):
 - Two [2] negative Tuberculosis (TB) screening tests **OR** a negative chest x-ray report **if** you have had a previous positive TB test.
NOTE: *The Tuberculosis screenings may not be older than nine [9] months on the first day of class. If using a chest-x-ray report, please call 339-6311 for further instructions.*

1st Test {

- Receive TB skin test
- Return to clinic in 48 hours to have skin test read

2nd Test {

- A minimum of 1 week after the 1st TB skin test was read, return to the clinic to receive 2nd TB skin test
- Return to clinic in 48 hours to have 2nd TB skin test read

Official documentation for TB tests must include:

- ✓ The name of the facility where test was completed.
- ✓ Student’s name
- ✓ Dates of skin tests
- ✓ Dates TB skin tests were read
- ✓ Results listed in millimeters (___mm)

Please note: “self” reads and blood test results for TB are not acceptable!

- Laboratory evidence of **immunity** to Measles, Mumps, Rubella (positive titers [3]) **or** documented evidence of two [2] Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) vaccinations.
- Laboratory evidence of immunity to Hepatitis B (positive titer) **or** documented evidence of at least one Hepatitis B vaccination. **NOTE:** *Students are strongly advised to complete the Hepatitis B vaccine series as health care providers are at an increased risk of contracting the disease. Anyone preferring to sign a declination form must complete this process prior to the first day of class. Please contact the Nursing Department for additional information at 970-339-6311.*



Failure to provide all “official” documentation listed above at the beginning of the first day of class will result in your being withdrawn from the Nurse Aide Program **without** tuition refunds.
