

Transfer Agreement

Aims Community College, AA in Criminal Justice Directed Studies to the University of Northern Colorado, BA in Criminal Justice

This transfer agreement was developed in accordance with the CCHE Statewide Transfer Policy (November 7, 2002) and with the UNC Transfer Course Guide for Colorado Community Colleges.

Although a formal transfer agreement is not required to assure acceptance of 60 semester credit hours of the AA Criminal Justice Directed Studies at Aims toward the Criminal Justice degree at UNC, this transfer agreement emphasizes the spirit of cooperation and close working arrangements between the two programs and the two institutions.

This agreement's goal is to make clear to students exactly which Aims courses should be taken to ensure a timely completion of the BA degree in Criminal Justice at UNC.

TRANSFER TO UNC GENERAL EDUCATION FULFILLMENT

Aims students will complete courses consistent with the General Education Transfer Courses and in doing so will assure waiver of the General Education Courses at UNC. (See attached Criminal Justice Associate of Arts Degree "UNC transfer" worksheet.

So they will transfer with courses most likely to be needed as core classes, or prerequisites for required or suggested courses for UNC's BA in Criminal Justice, Aims Criminal Justice transfer students are encouraged to take the following courses at Aims.
