- Must provide a Plan of Study that supports your selection
- Need to verify the ability to transport themselves to the college
- Attend a **mandatory information session on the chosen program**
- Complete a panel interview process

- Skills: mechanically inclined, analytical and logical, have communication and Computer skills; enjoy working with your hands.
