- Need to verify the ability to transport themselves to the college
- Attend a **mandatory information session on the chosen program**
- Complete a panel interview process

Course Requirements:

- Attendance is mandatory - Course work is not easily made up or able to be recreated at home
- RTV 101 and RTV 108 will run the first semester
- RTV 210 and RTV 211 will run the second semester
- Internet and computer access to take online tests, quizzes, and assignments
