Prerequisites

- Complete the Career Academy Scholarship application packet as provided by your high school counselor
- Document a current Accuplacer reading score of 62 or ACT Reading score of 17

Course Requirements

- Attendance is mandatory - Course work is not easily made up or able to be recreated at home
 - Excused absences may be granted for extenuating and documented circumstances
 - All missed dates must be made up per the syllabus requirements
- 5 days of clinical attendance in 6-hour shifts is required. Clinicals will be scheduled outside of regular class hours near the end of the semester. Make-up days for clinical attendance will not be permitted.
- Comply with dress code requirements
- Comply with all course participation and/or behavior requirements as set by Aims Community College and instructor discretion
- American Databank background check and drug screen urinalysis with no disqualifiers
- Vaccinations
 - Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR) or MMR Titer
 - TB Skin Test – Must be current (Received within two months of the start of clinical)
- Students who do not attain a grade of 75% or higher in NUA 101 will not be allowed to take NUA 170.
- Students who fail a critical objective in NUA 101 will be failed from the course.

Supplies Needed

- Textbooks will be supplied for Career Academy Scholarship students. White tennis shoes will be required for NUA 170 and students will need a watch with a second hand.

Certification

To be eligible to apply for the State of Colorado nurse aide certification, the student must earn an “S” grade in the NUA 170 and “C” or above in the written components of NUA 101. Testing will be paid for by the college. Students will be required to provide their social security number to the state and be 16 in order to test.
