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**How to Meet Assessment Requirements:**

1. Show proof of successful previous college experience at a regionally accredited college.
  - a. Received an A.A., A.S. degree or higher.
  - b. Completed (C- or higher) a college-level mathematics and writing course within the past ten years (some exceptions determined by department), or
2. Show proof of minimum **ACT** scores of **17 Reading, 18 English, and 19 Math (for certain courses)**, or
3. Show proof of minimum **SAT** scores of **430/470\*\*\* Verbal (RC), 440/470\*\*\* Verbal (SS) and 460/500\*\*\* Math, or**
4. Take College Board's **Online Accuplacer Placement** test. Knowledge of computers is not necessary to take the test. It is administered untimed. No calculators allowed.
5. **NOTE:** ACT, SAT, Compass and Accuplacer scores must be no more than three years old.

**CNA:** Certified Nurse Aide candidates must take the Accuplacer Reading Comprehension exam and **must receive a score of 62 or higher** in order to qualify for CNA classes.

**Early Childhood Education Program:** Students may enroll in ECE 101 or ECE 111, **concurrent with ONLY one developmental course**, if all other scores meet college level assessment requirements. Contact ECE Department Chair with questions.

**Welding Technology Degree or Technician Certificate Programs (06/23/15):** Students are not eligible if their Accuplacer scores are below minimum (RC<40, SS<50, ART<40, EAL<30). Certificate program requires students to complete CCR 092 and MAT 050, if placement scores are below college level. Degree program requires students to complete CCR 092, CCR 093 and/or CCR 094 and MAT 050, if placement scores fall below college level. May complete remedial education requirements concurrent with Welding Program.
