PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

STEPS TO ENROLL

- 1. Possess a current, valid regular driver license.
- 2. Complete and pass a
 Department of Transportation
 (DOT) physical exam and
 obtain a DOT medical card.
- 3. Complete and pass a drug screening.
- 4. Obtain a Commercial Learner Permit (CLP).

PAYMENT/FUNDING OPTIONS

- We accept cash, checks and credit cards.
- Funding may be available from community organizations such as Employment Services of Weld County.
- Funding may be available through your employer.

Please note: Aims Financial Aid is not available for CDL classes.

CLASS A

Types of vehicles requiring a Class A license:

- Tractor-trailers
- Truck and trailer combinations

Class Options:

- Training sessions are three or four weeks (120 or 150 hours), depending on whether the individual has a Commercial Learner Permit.
- The training program includes the Class A test with an Aims state-certified, third-party examiner.

CLASS B

Types of vehicles requiring a Class B license:

- Straight trucks
- Large passenger buses (15 passengers or more)
- Box trucks
- Dump trucks

Class Options:

 Training sessions are one week (40 hours) of in-truck and classroom instruction.

PASSENGER ENDORSEMENT

Aims offers testing for a Passenger Endorsement, which is required to drive a vehicle carrying more than 15 passengers.

Individuals must provide their own bus or vehicle for the test.
