Active Aardvarks: Loveland Fort Lupton Windsor Greeley

Folklore in Literature: Loveland Fort Lupton Windsor Greeley

In this course students will learn and gain basic life skills that they can use in their individual environments as they begin to become more independent in their everyday lives. Students will gain basic skills through hands-on learning including cooking, personal safety, cloth mending, budgeting, unplugged entertainment, and navigation. At the end of the week, each student will take home an assortment of materials and skills learned along the way!

We will discover Hawaii's traditions, cultures, ideologies, myths, facts, and controversies. We will learn how Hawaii went from a monarchy, to a territory, and ended up as America's 50th State. We will learn a little about land formations, build and erupt our own volcanoes, learn how to make leis, explore music with instruments and dance, all while having fun!

Junior First Responder: Windsor Y AM Y

Do you want to learn about saving lives, being a firefighter, emergency medical services (EMS) or law enforcement? In this fun, interactive and educational course, students will learn from professionals who work and train as first responders in our own communities. Held in the Public Service Institute at Aims Community College, students will play games, do crafts and see live training in-action at our state of the art training grounds. Students will also focus on the skills necessary to become a first responder, such as critical thinking, leadership and teamwork. With visits from the local Fire and Police departments, students will be able to explore the many career options held within these fields.

Lights, Camera, Action: Greeley

Video production is becoming increasingly prevalent in today's digital world. Creativity and technology come together in Lights, Camera, Action! In this fun and interactive class, students will learn the necessary skills and confidence to produce a short film, in-field interviews, and even go live on Aims Radio. From brainstorming and storyboarding, to lighting, audio, filming and editing, learning the basic steps of performing, acting on film, to video producing; deciding which shots are worthy of a final video. Parents/Guardians will receive their students' final film via email once they are finished. (Please note: the film may take up to a few weeks to complete and email)

Mad Science: Fort Lupton • Greeley •

Dive right into the wonderful world of Science! Kids will explore a variety of introductory topics and learn about the many different fields of science including geology, biology, and chemistry. Through hands-on experiments, students will become scientists, formulating a hypothesis, exploring variables, and then interacting with lab experiments such as elephant toothpaste, DIY ice cream, cracking geodes and more! Students will get to take home a few of the small, educational science-themed toys that emphasized the concepts they learned that day.

Ocean Exploration: Loveland * Fort Lupton * Greeley *

In this class, we will discover the wonders of the ocean! Learners will explore the four basic concepts of oceanography: physical, geological, chemical and biological. We will learn about different ocean ecosystems, study amazing sea creatures, and ponder what would happen if the oceans dried up. Become an environmental steward and learn how we can reduce the threat to our oceans, even here in Colorado!

Photography: Windsor Greeley

Photography is a great way to introduce kids to the concepts of artistic expression and storytelling. Students will learn how to see, and capture, the beauty in everyday life using real DSLR cameras under the supervision of a professional photographer. By the end of the week, they will understand photography concepts like shutter speed, aperture settings, and ISO, as well as develop their artistic eye! We'll talk about what makes for good photography and have the chance to review photos taken throughout the week. On the final day of class, students will get to take home their own SD card to access their photos and show off their learned skills!

Planting and Gardening Exploration: Loveland • Greeley •

Calling all gardeners! Come and explore the basics of plant life-cycles, merged with art activities! Students will have various opportunities to learn about healthy, home-grown nutrition, along with hands-on experiments, such as planting seeds and decorating pots. We will learn about various types of plants, vegetables, herbs and spices, the bugs that help our gardens grow, and the sustainability that gardening and planting brings.

Polymer Clay Jewelry Making: Loveland AM Windsor Greeley

Polymer clay is a fun and versatile material! Students can easily create colorful, sturdy and lightweight jewelry charms or small pieces of artwork. In this fun, hands-on class, students will learn how to take a simple block of clay, and through conditioning, shaping, and baking, turn it into amazing finished pieces. We'll cover the basics of working with polymer clay, researching our projects, and exploring a variety of techniques. At the end of class you'll leave with finished pieces of jewelry or artwork to call your own!

SafeSitter: Windsor Greeley

Is your child ready to stay home alone, watch younger brothers and sisters while you're away from the house, or babysit for younger children? Then maybe it's time for Safe Sitter®. Safe Sitter® is for boys and girls who are ready to learn the skills they need to care for themselves and younger children. This Safe Sitter® course teaches students how to practice important safety skills, how to handle emergencies, and how to treat illnesses and injuries. In addition, students learn important business skills, such as how to screen jobs, set a wage, and work with employers. At the end of this course, students will receive a Safe Sitter card.

Spanish! Language, Literacy and Culture: Loveland Culture: Lovelan

Spanish is recognized both as a local language with a long and rich history in the United States and as a global language spoken by millions of people around the world. This course introduces students to the Spanish language so that they can develop proficiency on a basic level. While focusing on vocabulary, phrases, and literacy practices, students will also be immersed in Spanish-speaking cultures such as Spain, Mexico and Central America. Students will learn differences in values, attitudes and actions as they investigate different cultures through hands-on activities and crafts.

Take the Stage: Loveland Windsor Greeley

In this fun and hands-on class, students will be exposed to theater games and exercises designed to free their imaginations, build self-confidence, and encourage collaborative play with peers. Additionally, students will develop their characters and costumes, learn about script writing, acting techniques and dive into scenes! Through the exploration of a variety of character development and scene study, participants begin to build an actor's "Toolbox" in this class. They will also perform a play that will be recorded and distributed to the students' parents or guardians so they can see their actors/actresses hard at work!

Ukulele for Beginners: Loveland Greeley

Do you like music? Have you wanted to learn to play an instrument but felt overwhelmed? Join Ukulele for Beginners to learn how to hold the instrument and a pick, basic chords, and how to read music. We will learn songs, and perform class solos. Listening to different styles of Ukulele will help us find our own unique style. Join us, as we perfect our skills through practice and then show off at a fun concert on the final day of class!

Wilderness Survival: Loveland Fort Lupton Windsor Greeley

Our ancient ancestors were master bush-crafers. Living in Colorado we have access to 3.5 million acres of federally protected wilderness. Many of us have spent time camping and hiking throughout Colorado but how many of us could survive in this wilderness if we became lost or stranded? Wilderness Survival 101 teaches skills and strategies for dealing with unexpected and adverse circumstances. We will cover topics including: first aid, water sourcing and purification, navigation using a map and compass, fire craft, rope and knot skills, cooking methods, shelter building, 72-hour bags, clothing choices, food sources and the gear and tools necessary to survive in the wilderness.
