2021 Graduation





Carolyn (CJ) Renaud

"Education is about connecting passion, talent and knowledge."

After serving more than 20 years as a police officer, Carolyn (CJ) Renaud was encouraged to make a change. "My mentor told me I needed to leave law enforcement and go into education," she said. Aims Community College was the perfect stepping stone to achieving that goal.

Before she could pursue her Masters in Education, CJ needed a few prerequisite classes. Aims offered those classes at night, which allowed CJ to continue to work for the Aurora police department while going to school.

Driving from Greeley to Aurora and back every day and going to class at night was grueling. But, CJ promised herself she would never skip class no matter how tired she was from her drive home. She kept that promise and did so well in her biology class that she was exempted from the final.

Meeting students in all walks of life who were pursuing their education while navigating various challenges in life is one the things that made an impact on CJ

during her time at Aims. She also realized that "it doesn't matter if you are attending a 4-year or a 2-year institution, your education matters!"

After getting straight A's in all her biology and chemistry classes at Aims, CJ went on to earn her MA in Education from the University of Phoenix. Her first position in education was with Greeley-Evans District 6 in a newly created position as the Business & Community Partnership Administrator. That role enabled CJ to live out her passion for building partnerships to create opportunities for students and enrich communities. "Education is about connecting passion, talent and knowledge," she said.

In her current role as Senior Community Relations Liaison for Western Governors University, CJ builds relationships with community leaders, business owners and organizations to open pathways of opportunity for all individuals aspiring to increase their knowledge and skills.

CJ is a champion for affordable, accessible education throughout Northern Colorado, and it all started at Aims. "Aims is the best kept secret in Northern Colorado. It is a community college constantly putting the community first."
