The essential skill sheets are lists of the most commonly encountered qualities and skills typically necessary to be successful in a particular program or area of interest. The information contained in an essential skills sheet is not all-inclusive and is intended to be used as a guide only. Individual programs may have specific requirements or technical standards that must be met.

Physical

See objects 20 inches to more than 20 feet away

Sit for long periods of time

Stand/walk for long periods of time

Squat for long periods

Reach above shoulders

Reach below waist

Pinch, grasp, squeeze, and manipulate objects

Push, pull, lift, and/or support up to 50 pounds

Maintain safety of self and others

Use peripheral vision

Twist

Bend

Climb

Move quickly

Sustain repetitive movements

Cognitive

Perform multiple responsibilities concurrently

Apply knowledge from one situation to another

Combine knowledge and skills

Evaluate the complexity of jobs

Adaptability

Problem solve

Focus attention on task

Take measurements using specialized equipment

Calcuate whole numbers

Estimate times

Interpret scale drawings (blueprints, maps, schematics)

Measure angles

Measure distance or dimension
